RESOLUTION NO. 22-262

IN THE MATTER OF PROCLAIMING JULY 17-23, 2022, AS)
PRETRIAL, PROBATION, AND PAROLE SUPERVISION WEEK)

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Probation Department has made a significant contribution to the citizens of Fresno County for the last 112 years. Probation professionals play a unique and essential role in our justice system and communities. Probation is focused on helping justice-involved individuals transition out of the system permanently through transformative and evidence-based rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, the Probation Department embodies the American Probation and Parole Association's motto, "Restoring Trust, Creating Hope" through partnerships with other law enforcement agencies and community-based organizations to provide public safety services to our local neighborhoods. The professionals employed in this field faithfully supervise individuals on probation and recognize the public's supreme right to be safe guarded from criminal activity, as well as providing offenders with rehabilitative programs and referrals for various needed services; and

WHEREAS, Probation staff endorse prevention, intervention, advocacy, offender accountability, and perform crucial duties that support and protect victims of crime; and

WHEREAS, Probation's efforts to balance the need for accountability with individualized rehabilitative treatment and services, provide justice-involved individuals the support and opportunities needed to move onto a healthier and safer life pathway; and

WHEREAS, on any given day, the Fresno County Probation Department supervises approximately 13,000 adult and juvenile offenders. Annually, the department completes in excess of 30,000 reports, screenings, and assessments; this includes adult pre-sentencing and juvenile dispositional reports, violation of probation, pretrial assessments, warrant and probation modification reports to the Fresno County Superior Court; and

WHEREAS, Pretrial, Probation, and Parole Supervision Week is a time to recognize and honor the dedication and professionalism exhibited by Probation Department staff who strive to make our neighborhoods a safer place to live and raise families.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED at the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims July 17 through July 23, 2022, as Pretrial, Probation, and Parole Supervision Week in the County of Fresno, to highlight Probation's immense contributions to our communities and state.
