REASONS WHY THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The subject application proposes to vacate the public right-of-way of a segment of East Cole Avenue, from its intersection with North Fowler Avenue to its terminus, approximately 900 feet +/- southeast of said intersection. This section of East Cole Avenue, which is not currently included in the County's maintained mileage system. No construction or ground-disturbance is involved with this project, and no impacts to cultural or historical resources are anticipated. Therefore, the project will not have an impact on the environment.
