

1 **Whereas**, public districts for which the County Treasury is not the legal depository of
2 funds are not included in the County’s Teeter Plan without approval and agreement by the Board;
3 and

4 **Whereas**, the City of Fowler is a public district for which the County Treasury is not the
5 legal depository of funds; and

6 **Whereas**, the City of Fowler adopted Resolution No. 2454 on December 3, 2019, to
7 request inclusion in the Teeter Plan with respect to the allocation of property taxes; and

8 **Whereas**, in order for the Board to approve and agree to the inclusion of the City of
9 Fowler in the Teeter Plan, effective Fiscal Year 2020-21, the Board is adopting this resolution.

10 **Now, therefore, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno finds, resolves,**
11 **and determines as follows:**

12 **Section 1.** The recitals above are true and correct.

13 **Section 2.** The Board hereby approves the request by the City of Fowler and agrees
14 that, effective Fiscal Year 2020-21 and in subsequent fiscal years, the City of Fowler shall be
15 included in the County’s Teeter Plan under the Teeter Law, with respect to the allocation of
16 secured property tax revenues (but excluding assessments), as from time to time amended for
17 the County.
