WHEREAS, Section 12(b) of the Fresno County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to provide, by Ordinance or Resolution, for the compensation of elected officers; and

WHEREAS, Section 12(b) of the Fresno County Charter also requires the setting of the salaries of elected officers to occur prior to the commencement of the term of office and no later than sixty (60) days prior to the primary election for the elected officers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors as follows:

- I. The Assessor-Recorder shall receive an annual salary as follows:
 - a. Effective January 4, 2027, \$226,226.
 - b. Effective upon the implementation of any cost-of-living adjustment for appointed county department heads, the salary then in effect for the elected county department head shall be increased by the same percentage as the cost-of-living adjustment granted to the appointed county department heads (HDS Unit).
- II. The Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector shall receive an annual salary as follows:
 - a. Effective January 4, 2027, \$234,390.

1 b. Effective upon the implementation of any cost-of-living adjustment for
2 appointed county department heads, the salary then in effect for the
3 elected county department head shall be increased by the same
4 percentage as the cost-of-living adjustment granted to the appointed
5 county department heads (HDS Unit).

6 III. The County Clerk shall receive an annual salary as follows:

- 7 a. Effective January 4, 2027, \$202,254.
- 8 b. Effective January 3, 2028, the salary then being received shall be
9 increased by ten percent (10%).
- 10 c. Effective upon the implementation of any cost-of-living adjustment for
11 appointed county department heads, the salary then in effect for the
12 elected county department head shall be increased by the same
13 percentage as the cost-of-living adjustment granted to the appointed
14 county department heads (HDS Unit).

15 IV. The District Attorney shall receive an annual salary as follows:

- 16 a. Effective January 4, 2027, \$344,188.
- 17 b. Effective January 3, 2028, the salary then being received shall be
18 increased by five percent (5%).
- 19 c. Effective upon the implementation of any cost-of-living adjustment for
20 appointed county department heads, the salary then in effect for the
21 elected county department head shall be increased by the same
22 percentage as the cost-of-living adjustment granted to the appointed
23 county department heads (HDS Unit).

24 V. The Sheriff-Coroner-Public Administrator shall receive an annual salary
25 as follows:

- a. Effective January 4, 2027, \$311,454.

- 1 b. Effective January 3, 2028, the salary then being received shall be
2 increased by five percent (4.5%).
- 3 c. Effective upon the commencement of the Sheriff-Coroner-Public
4 Administrator's term of office, the elected official shall be eligible to
5 receive a uniform allowance equivalent to that being received by the
6 Undersheriff.
- 7 d. Effective upon the commencement of the Sheriff-Coroner-Public
8 Administrator's term of office, the elected official shall be eligible to
9 receive a ten percent (10%) Management or Executive P.O.S.T.
10 incentive. Eligibility for the incentive will end within the pay period two
11 and one-half (2 ½) years after January 4, 2027, unless a valid
12 Executive P.O.S.T. Certificate has been obtained by that date.
- 13 e. Effective upon the implementation of any cost-of-living adjustment for
14 appointed county department heads, the salary then in effect for the
15 elected county department head shall be increased by the same
16 percentage as the cost-of-living adjustment granted to the appointed
17 county department heads (HDS Unit).


