WHEREAS, the Local Public Health Preparedness Organization 1159 will receive new allocated funding of \$1,137,714 from the California Department of Public Health’s Emergency Preparedness Office to prevent, prepare and respond to the COVID-19 crisis; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the FY 2019-20 adopted appropriations and estimated revenues of the Special Revenue Fund 0080, Subclass 17359, Local Public Health Preparedness Organization 1159; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2019-20 Local Public Health Preparedness Organization 1159 as follows:




