2 Before the Board of Supervisors

3 of the County of Fresno

4 **Resolution Establishing the Appropriations Limit**
5 **for the County of Fresno for Fiscal Year 2021-22**

6 WHEREAS, under Article XIII B, section 1, of the State Constitution, the total annual
7 appropriations subject to limitation of the County shall not exceed the appropriations limit of the
8 County for the prior year adjusted for the change in the cost of living and the change in
9 population, except as otherwise provided in Article XIII B of the State Constitution; and

10 WHEREAS, Government Code section 7910 requires the governing body of each local
11 jurisdiction to annual establish by resolution its appropriations limit for the following fiscal year
12 under Article XIII B of the State Constitution at a regularly scheduled meeting or noticed special
13 meeting; and

14 WHEREAS, Government Code section 25214.1, subdivision (a), requires that on or
15 before July 1 of each year, the board shall adopt a resolution establishing the appropriations
16 limits for the County Service Areas, if they meet certain qualifications stated in that section; and

17 WHEREAS, Fresno County Service Areas Nos. 1, 2, 5, 7, 14, 19, 23, 30, 33, 43, and 44
18 (each a "CSA," and collectively, "CSAs") meet the qualifications in Government Code section
19 25214.1; and

20 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors ("Board") is the governing body of the County of
21 Fresno ("County") and the CSAs; and

22 WHEREAS, Government Code section 25214.1, subdivision (b), provides that the Board
23 may include the proceeds of taxes for all county service areas within the County's own
24 appropriations limit; and

25 WHEREAS, the base year appropriations limit for the County, for Fiscal Year 1986-87,
26 was \$107,238,056; and

27 WHEREAS, each fiscal year since the base year, the Board has established the
28 appropriations limit for the County as required by Government Code section 7902, so that the

1 appropriations limit of the County in each fiscal year is equal to the appropriations limit for the
2 prior fiscal year multiplied by the product of the change in cost of living, and the change in
3 population for the calendar year preceding the beginning of the fiscal year for which the
4 appropriations limit is determined, and adjusted for other changes required or permitted by
5 Article XIII B of the California Constitution; and

6 WHEREAS, the appropriations limit for the County, for Fiscal Year 2020-21, was
7 established as \$660,949,966; and

8 WHEREAS, after the Board established the appropriations limit for the County for Fiscal
9 Year 2020-21, the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector (“ACTTC”) determined that it
10 should have been \$659,187,433, and that is the amount that ACTTC used in its calculation of
11 the appropriations limit for the County for Fiscal Year 2021-22; and

12 WHEREAS, the appropriations limit for the County for Fiscal Year 2021-22 shall include
13 the CSAs, as stated in Attachment A to this resolution; and

14 WHEREAS, ACTTC discovered an error in the Fiscal Year 2010-11 calculation of the
15 appropriations limits for the CSAs, and has corrected that error for purposes of its calculation of
16 the Fiscal Year 2021-22 appropriations limits for the CSAs, and for purposes of showing what
17 the Fiscal Year 2020-21 appropriations limits for the CSAs should have been; and

18 WHEREAS, for at least 15 days before the date of this resolution, documentation used in
19 the determination of the appropriations limit for the County for Fiscal Year 2021-22 was
20 available for public inspection in the office of the Clerk of the Board and the office of ACTTC; and

21 WHEREAS, before adopting this resolution, the Board gave the public, including any
22 affected taxpayers, the opportunity to present any evidence or testimony for or against the
23 Board taking such action;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

25 1. Under Government Code section 7901, subdivision (b), the County selects the
26 change in population within the incorporated portion of the County as the “change in population”
27 factor used in the calculation of the appropriations limit for the County for Fiscal Year 2021-22.



3. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.


