WHEREAS, on September 8, 1952, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors declared the formation of a water district under California Water District Law named Westlands Water District. Westlands Water District currently serves approximately 530,000 acres within Fresno County and transports water to the Cities of Huron and Coalinga and unincorporated communities in Fresno County; and

WHEREAS, Farmers in Westlands Water District are responsible for 28% of the economic value of fresh fruit, nut, and vegetable crops produced in Fresno County. Economic activity in Westlands Water District supports over 35,000 jobs; and

WHEREAS, Westlands Water District growers have adopted modern technology and strategies to advance water efficiency. Westlands continually invests in conservation and the communities it serves.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby commemorate Westlands Water District 70th Anniversary and recognize their contributions to the communities of Fresno County.
