RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Fresno County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County will receive an estimated \$24,533,062 in RMRA funding in FY 2022-23 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the fifth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding and such funding will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing of aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County has undergone a public process to ensure public input into the community's transportation priorities and the SB 1 Project List (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System to develop the attached SB 1 Project List to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

1 WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate streets/roads,
2 bridges, and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the County in FY 2022-23, and provide
3 financing for many similar projects into the future; and

4 WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that
5 the County's streets and roads are in at-risk condition, and this revenue will help the County increase the
6 overall quality of the road system and over the next decade will improve the general condition of our streets
7 and roads, by bringing selected roads into good-to-excellent condition; and

8 WHEREAS, the SB 1 Project List and overall investment in local street and road infrastructure with
9 a focus on basic maintenance and safety, as well as complete street infrastructure, and using cutting-edge
10 technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits both locally and from a
11 statewide perspective.

12 NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of
13 Supervisors of the County of Fresno, State of California, as follows:

- 14 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 15 2. The list of newly proposed projects that will be funded in in-part or solely with Fiscal Year
16 2022-23 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenue, is attached hereto as
17 Exhibit A.
- 18 3. The list of previously proposed and adopted projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2022-23
19 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery is attached hereto
20 as Exhibit B. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted Fiscal Year 2022-23 resolution,
21 the County is reaffirming to the public and the State the intent to fund these projects with
22 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues.
