

FRESNO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 26-269

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno recognizes the vital role that local farmers and agricultural producers play in supporting the regional economy and providing fresh, locally grown products to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Zoning Ordinance currently provides limited flexibility for agricultural produce stands, and the Board of Supervisors seeks to modernize these standards to better accommodate local agricultural operations and seasonal crop cycles; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments would establish clear use standards, including allowing for produce grown by an agricultural producer to be sold at an agricultural produce stand on any property owned, leased, or rented by the agricultural producer; and

WHEREAS, these revisions aim to provide farmers with greater operational flexibility while ensuring consistency with land-use regulations, maintaining public safety, and preserving the character of surrounding communities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to amend the Fresno County Zoning Ordinance accordingly to support local agriculture through reasonable, practical, and predictable standards for agricultural produce stands; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Zoning Ordinance requires the adoption of a Resolution of Intention is required to initiate the necessary studies and draft proposed amendments to the Fresno County Ordinance Code for the Planning Commission and/or Board consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board hereby directs the Department of Public Works and Planning and County Counsel to make the necessary investigations and studies as may be required to amend the Fresno County Zoning Ordinance, and to set a date for the prescribed public hearings, giving proper notice thereof.

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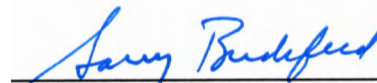
