**PROCLAIM JULY 20-26, 2025, AS PRETRIAL, PROBATION, AND)  
PAROLE SUPERVISION WEEK IN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO )**

**WHEREAS**, probation professionals play a unique and essential role in our justice system and communities and are focused on helping justice-involved individuals transition out of the criminal justice system permanently through transformative and evidence-based rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, as a member of the criminal justice system, the Fresno County Probation Department's mission is to provide protection for the community, support victim advocacy, and deliver essential services to the courts. This mission is accomplished through collaboration and partnerships which encompasses a continuum of sanctions and incentives including prevention/intervention programming, investigation, supervision, and incarceration; and

**WHEREAS**, on any given day, the Fresno County Probation Department supervises approximately 13,500 adult and juvenile offenders. Annually, the department completes more than 29,000 reports, screenings, and assessments; this includes adult presentencing and juvenile dispositional reports, pretrial assessments, warrants, and probation modification reports to the Fresno County Superior Court; and

**WHEREAS**, Pretrial, Probation, and Parole Supervision Week is a time to recognize and honor the dedication and professionalism exhibited by Probation Department staff who strive to make our neighborhoods a safer place to live and raise families; and


**WHEREAS**, the Probation Officers, Juvenile Correctional Officers and Victim Witness Advocates are diverse, trained experts, who are prepared to manage trauma and other needs of crime victims and justice-involved individuals, who safely supervise young people in custodial care, and connect them to the resources they need; and

**WHEREAS**, Probation staff have a profound impact on the health and safety of Fresno County by working to reduce recidivism through evidence-based programming and supervision. Probation's success helps ensure our community is safer to live and prosper within.


