SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ACQUIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO

The City of Fresno is reviewing final map T-6376 located on the west side of Armstrong Ave. just north of Church Ave. T-6376 will be required to annex into the City, construct ultimate street frontage improvements along Armstrong, and provide a safe route to school from their tract limits to the school located at the southeast corner of Church an Fowler. The tract will be within the City of Frenso limits but the safe route to school will be outside of city limits and is within the County's jurisdiction. The City is requesting that the County quitclaim the existing right-of-way for Armstrong and Church Avenues to the City of Fresno.
