11           SECTION 1: The Master Schedule of Fees, Charges and Recovered Costs for the County of  
12 Fresno, Section 3800 – General Services, is hereby amended, by amending subsections 3804 and 3809-  
13 3813, relating to the recovery of costs of Security, Fleet, and Facility Services of the Internal Services  
14 Department (ISD) to County departments and other public agencies, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached  
15 hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

16           SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from the date of its final passage.
