Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno Deciding 54 Claims and Ordering the Disposition of Excess Proceeds from 42 Parcels Sold in the County's March 2021 Sale of Tax-Defaulted Property, and Approving the Transfer of Excess Proceeds from the July 28, 2021 Chapter 8 Sale of Tax-Defaulted property to the Fresno County General Fund

WHEREAS, on March 12 through 15, 2021, under Revenue and Taxation Code, Division 1, Part 6, Chapter 7 (beginning with section 3691), the County sold 87 properties to satisfy the taxes, assessments, penalties, and costs then delinquent on those properties ("2021 Tax Sale"); and

WHEREAS, on April 23, 2021, the County Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector ("Tax Collector") recorded deeds to all purchasers of property at the 2021 Tax Sale; and

WHEREAS, the 2021 Tax Sale produced excess proceeds as follows: 45 parcels had no excess proceeds, and 42 parcels produced the total amount of \$2,894,418.57 in excess proceeds; and

WHEREAS, under Revenue and Taxation Code section 4675, each party of interest may file with the County a claim for excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale within one year after the April 23, 2021 recordation of the Tax Collector's deed to the purchaser; and

WHEREAS, by April 23, 2022, which was one year after the recordation of the Tax Collector's deeds to purchasers of property at the 2021 Tax Sale, the Tax Collector received 56 claims for excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale, as follows: for 13 parcels, there were multiple claims (a total of 39 claims); for 17 parcels, there was only one claim (a total of 17 claims); and for 12 parcels, there were no claims; and

WHEREAS, on February 28, 2023, the Board authorized the initiation of an interpleader action in the Superior Court for the two claims for excess proceeds from item 128 at the 2021 Tax Sale, which leaves 54 claims to be resolved by the Board; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2021, under Revenue and Taxation Code, Division 1, Part 6, Chapter 8, and "Agreement for Non-Profit Organization to Purchase Tax-Defaulted Property,"

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which is County agreement number 21-132 ("Chapter 8 Agreement"), the County sold 7
 properties to non-profit organization Habitat for Humanity Fresno, Inc. on July 28, 2021, and
 only one of those 7 parcels generated excess proceeds, in the amount of \$1,630.62; and

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2021, as provided by the Chapter 8 Agreement, the Tax
Collector recorded deeds to Habitat for Humanity Fresno, Inc., and the period to claim excess
proceeds ended one year later on August 16, 2022, as provided by Revenue and Taxation
Code section 4675, and the Tax Collector received no claim for excess proceeds from the 2021
Chapter 8 Sale; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish the distribution of excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale and Chapter 8 Sale, the Tax Collector has presented to the Board of Supervisors ("Board") a recommendation for each of the 54 claims for excess proceeds; and

WHEREAS, each of the claims identified in exhibit A to this resolution, titled "Claims Granted," contains sufficient information and proof to establish, to the satisfaction of the Board, as recommended by the Tax Collector, the claimant's right to excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale, in the amounts identified in exhibit A to this resolution, for the total amount of \$2,582,977.11; and

WHEREAS, the claim identified in exhibit B to this resolution, titled "Claims Denied Due to Insufficient Evidence," does not contain sufficient information and proof to establish, to the satisfaction of the Board, the claimant's right to any of the excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale; and

WHEREAS, there are insufficient excess proceeds to grant the claims identified in exhibit C to this resolution, titled "Claims Denied Due to Insufficient Excess Proceeds Available"; and

WHEREAS, after granting and denying claims as described above, \$197,888.37 in excess proceeds from 2021 Tax Sale and \$1,630.62 in excess proceeds from 2021 Chapter 8 Sale will remain for distribution to the County as provided in Revenue and Taxation Code section 4674; and WHEREAS, a description of the supporting documentation submitted with each claim for excess proceeds, and a statement of the reason for the determination on each claim, is on file with the Clerk of the Board, and the Board now acts in reliance upon that information; and

WHEREAS, on March 27, 2023, the Tax Collector mailed notice to each claimant that their claim would come before the Board for decision on this date; and

WHEREAS, all claimants wishing to address the Board on this matter received an opportunity to do so during the meeting at which the Board adopted this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD FINDS, RESOLVES, AND ORDERS as follows:

1. All of the recitals above are true and correct.

2. The 47 claims for excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale that are identified in

exhibit A are granted. For each claim identified in exhibit A, the Tax Collector shall, after waiting the 90-day period described in subdivision (g) of Revenue and Taxation Code section 4675, issue payment to the claimant as listed in exhibit A in the amount stated in exhibit A.

3. The 7 claims for excess proceeds from the 2021 Tax Sale that are identified in exhibits B and C are denied.

4. The balance of excess proceeds from the 12 items for which no claims were submitted, and the balance of excess proceeds remaining from the 4 items where a portion of the excess proceeds was not claimed or the claim did not include documents sufficient to establish a claimant's right to receive excess proceeds, in the total amount of \$197,888.37, shall be distributed to the County, as provided in Revenue and Taxation Code section 4674.

5. The balance of excess proceeds from the 2021 Chapter 8 Sale, in the total amount of \$1,630.62, shall be distributed to the County, as provided in Revenue and Taxation Code section 4674.
