RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO UNDERTAKE SUSTAINABLE GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT AND TO SERVE AS THE EXCLUSIVE GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY FOR PORTIONS OF THE PLEASANT VALLEY GROUNDWATER SUBBASIN

WHEREAS, the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act of 2014 ("SGMA"), signed into law on September 16, 2014, requires that each California groundwater basin or subbasin be managed by a Groundwater Sustainability Agency ("GSA"), or multiple GSAs, and that such management be implemented pursuant to an approved Groundwater Sustainability Plan ("GSP") or multiple GSPs; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno ("County") is a "local agency" as defined in Water Code section 10721, subdivision (n); and

WHEREAS, the Pleasant Valley Water District ("PVWD") previously decided to become the GSA for the entire Pleasant Valley Subbasin (Subbasin), even though portions of that subbasin are outside of PVWDs' jurisdictional boundary; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Water Resources has indicated that PVWD may not serve as the GSA for areas that are outside of its jurisdictional boundary; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coalinga, which is also a local agency as defined in Water Code section 10721, subdivision (n), lies within the portion of the Subbasin that is outside of PVWDs' jurisdictional boundary; and

WHEREAS, for the portions of the Subbasin where no other local agency as defined in Water Code section 10721, subdivision (n), has jurisdiction, the County is presumed, under Water Code section 10724 to be the GSA for that area; and

WHEREAS, the County now desires to declare its intention to undertake sustainable groundwater management and to serve as GSA in those portions of the Subbasin that are within the County's jurisdictional boundary, but outside of PVWDs' and City of Coalinga's jurisdictional boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Water Code section 10723, subdivision (a), authorizes a local agency under Water Code section 10721, subdivision (n), with water supply, water management, or land use responsibilities, overlying a groundwater basin to decide to become a GSA; and

WHEREAS, Water Code section 10723, subdivision (b), provides that, before deciding to become a GSA, a local agency must publish notice pursuant to Government Code section 6066 and hold a public hearing in the county overlying the groundwater basin where the agency intends to undertake sustainable groundwater management; and

WHEREAS, Water Code, section 10723.2 requires that a GSA consider the interests of all beneficial uses and users of groundwater, as well as those responsible for implementing GSPs; and

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2019 and April 26, 2019, the County published notice of a public hearing pursuant to Government Code, section 6066; and

WHEREAS, the County held a public hearing on May 7, 2019, to consider the adoption of this resolution and its decision to become a GSA for those portions of the Pleasant Valley Subbasin that are within the County's jurisdictional boundary, but outside of PVWDs' and City of Coalinga's jurisdictional boundaries, which the County designates as the "Fresno County Pleasant Valley GSA Area", for administrative purposes only; and

WHEREAS, after considering the issue and allowing for public testimony, the Board of Supervisors determined it to be in the best interest of the County to decide to serve as a GSA for the Fresno County Pleasant Valley GSA Area.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The County hereby elects to be the exclusive GSA for the Fresno County Pleasant Valley GSA Area.
- 2. The Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning (Director) is directed to submit within 30 days of this resolution a notice of intent to the California Department of Water Resources, pursuant to California Water Code, section 10723.8, subdivision (a).
- 3. Pursuant to Water Code, section 10723.4, the Director shall create and maintain a list of persons interested in receiving notices concerning the Fresno County Pleasant Valley formed GSA Area.
