IN THE MATTER OF PROCLAIMING THE MONTH) OF JUNE AS ELDER AND DEPENDENT ADULT) ABUSE AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, Fresno County includes a thriving community of older Americans deserving recognition of their contributions and sacrifices to ensure a better life for future generations; and

WHEREAS, Elder and dependent adult abuse is a serious problem that bears no association to socio-economic status, race, gender, ethnicity, educational background or geographic location; and

WHEREAS, The National Council on Aging estimates that nearly 5 million, or 1 in every 10, older Americans are abused each year and only 7% (350,000) of the abuse is reported; many victims do not report the abuse due to feelings of shame, fear, and helplessness; and

WHEREAS, Fresno County received approximately 4248 reports of adult abuse in 2019 and saw a 18% decrease in reports from the previous year; and

WHEREAS, Fresno County's elder and dependent adults deserve to live safely, with dignity and without fear or risk of exploitation; and

WHEREAS, An increase in community awareness is the first step toward the prevention of elder and dependent adult abuse.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby honor of the Older Americans Act, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes the month of June 2020 as Elder and Dependent Adult Abuse Awareness Month.
