WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that stop signs be installed at the intersection of Bliss and De Woody Avenues, making it a two-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Bliss and De Woody Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Bliss and De Woody Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Bliss and De Woody Avenues, stopping northbound and southbound traffic on Bliss Avenue.


