WHEREAS, the Director or the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that a stop sign be installed at the intersection of Dakota and Vineland Avenues, making it a one-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Dakota and Vineland Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Dakota and Vineland a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of a stop sign at the intersection of Dakota and Vineland Avenues, stopping eastbound traffic on Dakota Avenue.


