The Offices are committed to working tirelessly, in coordination with other law enforcement agencies such as the Fresno Police Department and the FBI, to arrest and prosecute these offenders.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby stand in solidarity with people of all races, ethnicities, religions, genders, and sexual orientations and adamantly oppose all acts of hate crime and hate speech.
