7 A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINDING OF CRITICAL NEED PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE
8 SECTION 7522.56(f)(1) AND WAIVE THE EXTRA-HELP WEEKLY MAXIMUM HOURS LIMITATION
9 FOR CALANDAR YEAR 2022 PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS SET FORTH IN THE SALARY
10 RESOLUTION SECTION 1100 AND PERSONNEL RULES 2040 AND 4240 :

11 **WHEREAS**, Deputy Director, Linda Espinosa, retired on March 30, 2022; and

12 **WHEREAS**, Linda Espinosa was most recently the Deputy Director in charge of Department of Social
13 Services Administration; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Linda Espinosa has the experience, knowledge, and familiarity with the day to day
15 management of DSS Administration and this makes her critical to continued ongoing normal
16 operations; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation
18 period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's
19 governing body finds and certifies the nature of the employment and that the appointment is necessary
20 to fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period has
21 passed; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Salary Resolution section 1100 and Personnel Rules 2040 and 4240 requires a maximum of
23 twenty-eight (28) hours worked per week, including overtime hours, for extra-help employees unless
24 the employers governing body waives the twenty-eight (28) hour per week maximum as listed on
25 Attachment A.
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1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors for County of Fresno (“County”)
2 does hereby determine and declare as follows: The Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Linda Espinosa
3 on an as-needed basis effective May 18, 2022, finding and certifying that the provisions of Government
4 Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period for retired employees
5 returning to employment as extra-help are not applicable to Linda Espinosa, because the nature of
6 Linda Espinosa’s employment and her appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position
7 before one-hundred eighty (180) days has passed following the date of Linda Espinosa’s retirement.

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
