OF ELIGIBILITY WORKER )	OF CRITICAL NEED PURSUANT TO
<u>WITH EXTRA HELP RETIREE )</u>	GOVT. CODE SECTION 7522.56(f)(1)

WHEREAS, Maria Castillo retire as Eligibility Worker on April 1, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services will have Maria Castillo assist with the workload while current staff attend training for the new consortia system CalSAWS; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body finds and certifies the nature of the employment and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period has passed.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Maria Castillo on an as-needed basis, effective June 12, 2023, finding and certifying that the provisions of Government Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) separation period for retired employees returning to employment as extra-help are not applicable to Maria Castillo, because of the nature of Maria Castillo's employment and her appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before 180 days has passed following the date of Maria Castillo's retirement.
