RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Government Code section 26909, subdivision (c)(1), permits a special district, by unanimous request of its governing board and unanimous approval of the Board of Supervisors, to replace the annual audit required by that section with an annual financial review; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for the West Fresno Red Scale Protective District ("District") on January 11, 2023, unanimously requested, by letter, a copy of which is attached to this resolution, to replace the District's annual audit with an annual financial review;

WHEREAS, the District is a Pest Protection District organized under provisions of the Citrus Pest District Law of the State of California, Statues 1939, Chapter 89, and a "district" or "special district" as defined by Government Code section 56036.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno gives its unanimous approval for West Fresno County Red Scale Protective District to replace its annual audit with an annual financial review in accordance with the provisions of Government Code section 26909, subdivision (c)(1). The initial financial review will cover the period of July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2021. The financial review shall be filed within 12 months of the end of the fiscal year under examination as provided in Government Code section 26909, subdivision (a)(2)(B)(ii).

Members of the Financial Reporting and Audits Division and Fresno County Board of Supervisors,

Pursuant to Government Code Section 26909 (c)(1), we request that it be approved that West Fresno County Redscale Protection Pest Control District may furnish a financial review on a yearly basis.

The conditions that must be met to qualify to report under an annual financial review are: (A) All of the special district's revenues and expenditures are transacted through the county's financial system.

(B) The special district's annual revenues do not exceed one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000).

West Fresno County Redscale Protection Pest Control District meets these conditions. All of the Districts' revenues and expenditures are transacted through the county's financial system. The District has had an approximate average revenue of \$40,000 per year for the last five years. The District has an average of 10 receipt deposits per year and an average of 10 disbursements per year.

The cost of a review is substantially less than that of an audit. Given the circumstances of the district, with a low number of overall transactions, and all transactions flowing through the county's financial system, we, the board members of West Fresno County Redscale Protection Pest Control District unanimously request that it be approved for the District to have an annual financial review.
