5 **RESOLUTION PROVIDING WORKERS' COMPENSATION COVERAGE FOR COUNTY OF FRESNO**
6 **VOLUNTEERS**

9 Whereas, the County of Fresno's Board of Supervisors desires to provide workers' compensation
10 coverage for County of Fresno volunteers pursuant to the provisions of Section 3363.5 of the Labor
11 Code; and

12 Whereas, the County of Fresno finds its best interests will be served by utilizing volunteers in the
13 provision of certain County of Fresno services; and

14 Whereas, said volunteers should be eligible for workers' compensation coverage while on duty;

15 **Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno**
16 **hereby finds and determines:**
17

18 1. That the public interest is best served by providing workers' compensation coverage to its
19 volunteers;

20 2. That County of Fresno volunteers shall be deemed to be employees for the purposes of
21 Division 4 of the California Labor Code while the persons actually perform volunteer services, provided
22 that the rights of volunteers shall be limited to those benefits set forth in Division 4 of the Labor Code.

23 This Resolution includes, but is not limited to, jail or other inmates of Fresno County rendering
24 service to it. This Resolution is retroactive to the full extent allowed by California law.
