**WHEREAS**, Throughout the year, professionals within the Fresno County Probation Department provide safe and secure housing for youth detained at the Juvenile Justice Campus and are mentors and role models to these youth; and

**WHEREAS**, The Probation Department partners with other law enforcement agencies and community based organizations to provide public safety services to our local neighborhoods, as well as providing offenders with rehabilitative programs and referrals for various needed services; and

**WHEREAS**, The Probation Department provides prevention, intervention, advocacy and offender accountability services that support and protect victims of crime. Probation, Parole and Pretrial Week is a time to recognize and honor the dedication and professionalism exhibited by Probation Department staff who strive to make our neighborhoods a safer place to live and raise families.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaim July 15-21, 2018, as Probation, Parole, and Pretrial Week in the County of Fresno, in recognition of their service to Fresno County residents.
