RE: Transfer of Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) Rule 20A Credits for Church Ave/MLK Undergrounding Project

Dear Director White,

I am reaching out to request the County's consideration of a transfer of \$1 million in unallocated PG&E Rule 20A credits to PM# 35067381 for the Church Ave/MLK project in Southwest Fresno. The estimated cost of the utility undergrounding project, as assessed by PG&E, is \$4,461,372, which exceeds the City's available credit balance of \$3,537,656. According to the regulations set forth by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), government entities with unallocated Rule 20A credits are permitted to transfer these credits to other agencies within their jurisdiction, thereby facilitating this request.

The City of Fresno has demonstrated its commitment to the Southwest Fresno community through the attached improvements map, which outlines investments exceeding \$25 million. The transfer of County credits will provide essential support for the undergrounding of utility lines by PG&E, with construction anticipated to commence in July of this year. The new West Fresno Center, part of the State Center Community College District (SCCCD), will provide expanded educational opportunities for Southwest Fresno area residents, improving access to workforce training and higher education. Transferring of these credits ensures modern infrastructure, such as underground utilities, will enhance the campus's safety, aesthetics, and long-term sustainability. This project will support the ongoing revitalization of the area, helping to attract students, businesses, and further investment in Southwest Fresno.


