# AMENDMENT I TO AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT, hereinafter referred to as Amendment I, is made and entered into this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 2021, by and between the **COUNTY OFFRESNO**, a Political Subdivision of The State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", and **CLEAN EARTH ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, INC.**, whose address is 350 Popular Church Road, Camp Hill, PA 17011, formerly known as **STERICYCLE ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, INC.**, a Delaware Corporation whose address is 28161 N. Keith Drive, Lake Forest, IL 60045, hereinafter referred to "**CONSULTANT**" (collectively the "parties").

WHEREAS, the parties entered into that certain Agreement, identified as COUNTY Agreement No. 17-316, effective the 20<sup>th</sup> day of June 2017, whereby CONSULTANT agreed to provide certain services for the operation of the regional, permanent household hazardous waste facility.

WHEREAS, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of April 2020, CONSULTANT changed its name from STERICYCLE ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, INC., a Delaware Corporation, to Clean Earth Environmental Solutions, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend COUNTY Agreement No. 17-316, regarding changes as stated below and restate the Agreement in its entirety.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. That all references in existing COUNTY Agreement No. 17-316 to Exhibit A be changed to read Revised Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein.
  - 2. All references to STERICYCLE ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, INC., in the Agreement shall be amended to refer to Clean Earth Environmental Solutions, Inc.
- 3. COUNTY and CONSULTANT agree that this Amendment I is sufficient to amend the Agreement; and that upon execution of this Amendment I, the Agreement and Amendment I together shall be considered the Agreement.

The Agreement, as hereby amended, is ratified and continued. All provisions, terms, covenants, conditions and promises contained in the Agreement, and not amended herein,
