WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (this "Board") on March 23, 2021 adopted its Resolution of Intention to vacate public road right-of-way of Sunset Avenue, lying adjacent to block 6 of Map of Sunset Heights, according to the map thereof recorded in Book 7 of Subdivision Maps at Page 51, Fresno County Records, approximately .047 acres (Vacation Application No. V19-03); and

WHEREAS, this Board find that the Resolution of Intention to vacate said public right-ofway was duly published and posted pursuant to Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highway Code.

WHEREAS, Streets and Highway code Section 8340, subdivision (a), provides, "[a] public entity may reserve and except from the vacation the easement and right at any time, or from time to time, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, and renew sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over, and across a street or highway proposed to be vacated and, pursuant to any existing franchise or renewals thereof, or otherwise, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment, and fixtures for the operation of gas pipelines, telegraphic and telephone lines, railroad lines, and for the transportation or distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, ammonia, and water, and for incidental purposes, including access to protect these works from all hazards in, upon, and over the street or highway proposed to be vacated"; and

WHEREAS, Streets and Highways Code section 8340, subdivision (c), provides" "[i]f there are in place public utility facilities that are in use, a public entity shall, unless the legislative body determines the public convenience and necessity otherwise require, reserve, and except from the

vacation any easement and right necessary to maintain, operate, replace, remove, or renew the public utility facilities."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that this Board finds, after considering all evidence submitted, and providing the public with an opportunity to testify, and orders as follows:

- (1) That the public road right-of-way of Sunset Avenue, lying adjacent to block 6 of Map of Sunset Heights, according to the map thereof recorded in Book 7 of Subdivision Maps at Page 51, Fresno County Records, approximately .047 acres, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.
 - a. The vacation is determined to meet the criteria for general vacation pursuant to Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code (collectively "Vacation Laws"; and
 - b. The right-of-way is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and
 - The right-of-way is not useful as a nonmotorized transportation facility, pursuant to Section 892 of the Streets and Highways Code; and
 - d. The vacation is consistent with the County General Plan.
- (2) That the proposed vacation is consistent with the General Plan adopted by the County of Fresno.
- (3) Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 892, that said portion of the public road right-of-way is not useful as a nonmotorized transportation facility,
- (4) That the public road right-of-Sunset Avenue, lying adjacent to block 6 of Map of Sunset Heights, according to the map thereof recorded in Book 7 of Subdivision Maps at Page 51, Fresno County Records, approximately .047 acres or as particularly described in Exhibit A, is hereby vacated, subject to the order (5) below.
- (5) As provided in Streets and Highways Code Section 8325, subdivision (a), "the Clerk shall cause a certified copy of the resolution of vacation, attested by the clerk under seal, to be recorded without acknowledgment, certificate of acknowledgment, or further proof in the office of the recorder of the county in which the property is located. No fee shall

2	(6) That the Department of Public Works and Planning, within 3 Days after this resolution is	
3	adopted, will file with the Clerk to maintain for all time along with this resolution, a map	
4	of the area and easement described in (5)(a).
