

The Fresno County Board of Supervisors is giving notice that at their regularly scheduled meeting on June 10, 2025, at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the Fresno County Hall of Records, Board of Supervisors Chambers, 3rd Floor, 2281 Tulare Street, Fresno, California, they will consider adoption of the ordinance summarized below.
SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE
Amend the Ordinance Code of Fresno County by amending Title 10 to add Chapter 10.48 Unlawful Possession of Detached Catalytic Converters, which will create a criminal or administrative penalty for the unlawful possession of detached catalytic converters in the unincorporated portions of Fresno County. Anyone in possession of one or more detached catalytic converters will be required to demonstrate valid proof of ownership or be subject to fines or jail time.
