2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF**  
3 **FRESNO INITIATING PROCEEDINGS TO RE-APPORTION AND RE-LEVY PART OF**  
4 **THE BENEFIT ASSESSMENT PREVIOUSLY LEVIED UNDER THE UNIFORM**  
5 **STANDBY CHARGE PROCEDURES ACT FOR WATER CONTRACT**  
6 **ADMINISTRATION AND MILLERTON LAKE PUMP READY-TO-SERVE**  
7 **MAINTENANCE FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 34 (MILLERTON NEW TOWN)**

8 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (Board) formed County Service Area No.  
9 34 (CSA 34) in 1986 to provide a wide variety of governmental services for the  
10 community of Millerton New Town; and

11 WHEREAS, Tentative Tract Map No. 4968 (TTM 4968) lies wholly within the  
12 boundaries of CSA 34; and

13 WHEREAS, to comply with a condition of approval of TTM 4968, a  
14 developer/landowner has requested the formation of CSA 34, proposed zone D (CSA  
15 34D), also known as Renaissance at Bella Vista; and

16 WHEREAS, for the reasons stated above, the formation of CSA 34D is proposed  
17 under Article 8 of the County Service Area Law and to that end the Board is also, by  
18 separate resolution today, declaring its intention to form CSA 34D; and

19 WHEREAS, the facilities and services provided by the County in CSA 34 include,  
20 among other things: (1) administering three contracts between the County and three  
21 other agencies (Arvin-Edison Water Storage District, Lower Tule River Irrigation District,  
22 and the Deer Creek and Tule River Authority) to provide a firm, long-term surface water  
23 supply for delivery to all of the parcels in CSA 34, zone A (also known as Brighton Crest),  
24 all of the parcels in CSA 34, zone C (also known as Bella Vista), and all of the parcels  
25 in CSA 34, proposed zone D (also known as Renaissance at Bella Vista), and a portion  
26 of the parcels in CSA 34 that are not within zones A, C or proposed zone D (but which  
27 previously included the area comprising most of proposed zone D) (collectively, Contract  
28 Administration); and (2) maintaining in ready-to-serve status the water pumping facilities  
located on a submerged platform in Millerton Lake that pump untreated surface water  
from Millerton Lake (a) to storage and treatment facilities that currently process raw

1 water to produce potable water for domestic uses for delivery to Brighton Crest, Bella  
2 Vista and Renaissance at Bella Vista, and (b) and for use on the golf course in Brighton  
3 Crest for fairway turf irrigation (collectively, Lake Pumps); and

4 WHEREAS, under Government Code section 25217.1, subdivision (d), before  
5 the formation of CSA 34D may be approved by the Board, user fees and benefit  
6 assessments to pay for the services described above must be approved by owners of  
7 benefitted and specially benefitted properties as required by Proposition 218 (California  
8 Constitution, Article XIII D, sections 4 and 6); and

9 WHEREAS, Government Code section 25215.6, authorizes the County to impose  
10 a benefit assessment within CSA 34 under the Uniform Standby Charge Procedures Act  
11 (Government Code sections 54984 through 54984.9) for the costs of the Contract  
12 Administration and the Lake Pumps; and

13 WHEREAS, the map attached to this resolution as exhibit A, and further detailed  
14 in exhibits A-1 and A-2, identifies, by which parcels are shaded, the territory within CSA  
15 34 where a benefit assessment for the costs of the Contract Administration and the Lake  
16 Pumps was previously levied, which territory includes most of CSA 34 zone A (also  
17 known as Brighton Crest), most of CSA 34 zone C (also known as Bella Vista), most of  
18 CSA 34 proposed zone D (also known as Renaissance at Bella Vista), and portions of  
19 CSA 34 outside of zones A, C and proposed zone D; and

20 WHEREAS, the proposed development and formation of CSA 34 proposed zone  
21 D (CSA 34D) within a portion of the area where the Board previously levied a benefit  
22 assessment (Board Resolution 16-141, adopted March 15, 2016) to pay for the costs of  
23 Contract Administration and the Lake Pumps necessitates re-apportionment and re-levy  
24 of a portion of that prior assessment, without in any way affecting the balance of that  
25 prior assessment, including the assessment as levied in Brighton Crest and Bella Vista;  
26 and

27 WHEREAS, for purposes of this proceeding, the area where the previously levied  
28 assessment is to be reapportioned and re-levied due to further development, is identified

1 as the shaded parcels as shown in exhibits A-1 through A-3, and includes most of  
2 CSA 34D; and

3 WHEREAS, the "Engineer's Report on Rates and Charges for Domestic Water  
4 and Sewer Services, and Water Contract Administration and Millerton Lake Pump  
5 Ready to Serve Benefit Assessments for Fresno County Service Area No.34 (Millerton  
6 New Town), and Zone D (TT 4968)" (Engineer's Report), prepared by Richard H.  
7 Heyman, a registered professional engineer, and dated September 1, 2017 is on file with  
8 the Clerk to the Board; and

9 WHEREAS, the proposed benefit assessment for the costs of the Contract  
10 Administration and the Lake Pumps is based upon the Engineer's Report, which  
11 includes (1) a description of the assessment and the method by which it will be imposed,  
12 (2) a compilation of the amount of the assessment proposed for each parcel subject to  
13 the assessment, (3) a statement of the methodology and rationale followed in  
14 determining the degree of benefit conferred by the service for which the assessment is  
15 made, and (4) other factors required by Government Code section 54984.2; and

16 WHEREAS, Exhibit B to this resolution identifies all of the parcels that receive a  
17 special benefit from the Contract Administration and the Lake Pumps, upon which the  
18 benefit assessment is to be re-apportioned and re-levied, and the amount of the re-  
19 apportioned assessment for each parcel;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF  
21 FRESNO DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, AND RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

22 **Section 1.** The above recitals are all true and correct.

23 **Section 2.** The Board hereby proposes to proceed under the Uniform Standby  
24 Charge Procedures Act to re-apportion and re-levy a portion of the prior assessment  
25 under Resolution 16-141, and to levy and collect that re-apportioned benefit assessment  
26 in CSA 34D. The parcels to be assessed are identified in Exhibit B.

27 **Section 3.** Although it is not required, a public meeting of the County is set for  
28 **November 1, 2017, at 3:00 p.m.,** there will be a public meeting at **2220 Tulare Street**

1 **8<sup>th</sup> Floor Conference Room A, Fresno, CA. 93721**, for public testimony concerning  
2 the proposed assessment (collectively, Public Meeting). The Public Meeting shall be  
3 held under Government Code section 54984.6 and may be continued from time to time  
4 by the County official conducting the Public Meeting without further notice by the Board,  
5 but in any event not later than seven days before the date set by the Board for the public  
6 hearing described below.

7 **Section 4.** A public hearing of the Board on the proposed assessment is  
8 hereby set for **December 5, 2017, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon after as practicable, but**  
9 **in any case only after completion of the public hearing on the proposed formation**  
10 **of CSA 34D, and only if there is no majority protest in that formation proceeding,**  
11 in the Board Room of the Fresno County Board of Supervisors, Room 301, Hall of  
12 Records, 2281 Tulare Street, Fresno, California 93721, for hearing all objections and  
13 protests to the proposed assessment as set forth in the Engineer's Report (collectively,  
14 Public Hearing). The Public Hearing shall be held under Government Code section  
15 53753. The Public Hearing may be continued from time to time by the Board without  
16 further notice by the Board.

17 **Section 5.** The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Public  
18 Works and Planning (Director) or his designees, to prepare the assessment ballots and  
19 assessment ballot instructions, any materials for the change, withdrawal, or substitution  
20 of assessment ballots, including substitute assessment ballots and substitute  
21 assessment ballot instructions, any materials for co-owner assessment ballots and co-  
22 owner assessment ballot instructions, and any other forms and materials, as the Director  
23 or his designees deem necessary or appropriate, with respect to the submission of  
24 assessment ballots by record property owners of the parcels to be assessed, under  
25 Government Code section 53753.

26 **Section 6.** The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Director or his  
27 designee to prepare a joint notice of the Public Meeting and the Public Hearing (Joint  
28 Notice). The Joint Notice shall contain:

- 1 A. The dates, times, and locations of the Public Meeting and Public Hearing;
- 2 B. The total amount of the proposed benefit assessment chargeable to all of the
- 3 affected parcels;
- 4 C. The amount of the proposed benefit assessment for each affected parcel;
- 5 D. The basis upon which the amount of the proposed benefit assessment was
- 6 calculated;
- 7 E. A statement that the assessment will continue in successive years through
- 8 Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the amounts stated in Exhibit B and the Engineer's
- 9 Report;
- 10 F. The reason for the assessment, namely the costs of the Contract
- 11 Administration and the Lake Pumps;
- 12 G. The address to which property owners may mail a protest against the
- 13 proposed benefit assessment;
- 14 H. The telephone number and address of an individual or office that interested
- 15 persons may contact to receive additional information about the proposed
- 16 benefit assessment;
- 17 I. An assessment ballot that includes the address for receipt of the ballot and a
- 18 place where the person returning the ballot may indicate his or her name, a
- 19 reasonable identification of the parcel, and his or her support or opposition to
- 20 the proposed benefit assessment;
- 21 J. Assessment ballot instructions as described in Section 5 of this resolution;
- 22 and
- 23 K. A statement that the proposed benefit assessment shall not be imposed if the
- 24 ballots submitted in opposition to the assessment exceed the ballots
- 25 submitted in favor of the assessment, with ballots weighted according to the
- 26 proportional financial obligation of the affected property.

27 The Director or his designee shall deliver the Joint Notices to the Clerk to the  
28 Board no later than October 20, 2017.

1           **Section 7.** The Board hereby authorizes and directs the Clerk to the Board to  
2 sign and mail, postage prepaid, in the United States mail, no later than October 20,  
3 2017, the Joint Notices (which shall include assessment ballots and assessment ballot  
4 instructions as described above in Section 6 of this resolution), to the record property  
5 owners of the parcels to be assessed. On the face of the envelope in which each Joint  
6 Notice is sent, there shall appear, in no smaller than 16-point bold type, the words  
7 “OFFICIAL BALLOT ENCLOSED.” Upon the Clerk to the Board’s completion of the  
8 mailing of the Joint Notices, the Clerk is hereby directed to file with the Board an affidavit  
9 setting forth the time and manner of the compliance with the requirements of this  
10 resolution for mailing the Joint Notices.

11           **Section 8.** The Director of Public Works and Planning and his designees, who  
12 may be any employees of the County Department of Public Works and Planning that he  
13 appoints, are hereby designated and authorized to tabulate the assessment ballots  
14 (including substitute assessment ballots and co-owner assessment ballots) submitted,  
15 and not withdrawn, in support of or opposition to the assessment referred to in this  
16 resolution. Each of those persons may, in their discretion appoint assistants, including,  
17 but not limited to, any employees of the County Administrative Office, including further  
18 any employees of the Office of the Clerk, to help tabulate the assessment ballots  
19 (including substitute assessment ballots and co-owner assessment ballots). The Board  
20 hereby finds and determines that each of the persons described in this Section 8 is an  
21 impartial person who does not have a vested interest in the outcome of the assessment.

22           **Section 9.** If the Board imposes the proposed re-apportioned benefit  
23 assessment, the resolution imposing the assessment shall provide that the assessment  
24 will continue in successive years through Fiscal Year 2021-2022 in the amounts stated  
25 in Exhibit B and the Engineer’s Report. For years after Fiscal Year 2021-2022, the Board  
26 may, by resolution, continue the assessment at the same amount, without increase. If  
27 new, increased, or extended assessments are proposed, the Board will comply with the  
28 notice, protest, and hearing procedures in Government Code section 53753.

1           **Section 10.** If the Board imposes the proposed re-apportioned benefit  
2 assessment, the resolution imposing the assessment shall provide that the assessment  
3 will be collected annually at the same time, and in the same manner, and subject to the  
4 same penalties, as the general taxes of the County.

5           **Section 11.** The Board hereby finds and determines that it took all of the  
6 foregoing actions and made all of the foregoing findings in full compliance with the law,  
7 including, without limitation, the Uniform Standby Charge Procedures Act, Article XIII D  
8 of the California Constitution, Government Code section 53753, and any other law  
9 referred to in this resolution.

10           **Section 12.** This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.










