The Department is divided into two divisions: Patrol and Support Services. Each division is led by its own commander. In addition, the Police Department has its own full-time 24 hours a day dispatch center, Animal Control Officer, and a Property and Evidence Technician; and

WHEREAS The quality and effectiveness of these services is vitally dependent upon the efforts and skilled officers and staff of the Coalinga Police Department who for 90 years have contributed to the quality of life that residents and visitors alike enjoy and rely upon in the City of Coalinga.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors recognizes and honors the Coalinga Police Department on their 90TH Anniversary.
