SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ACQUIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO

The City of Fresno is reviewing plans to replace the Fowler Avenue Bridge over Mill Creek. Mill Creek is between Clinton Avenue and Olive Avenue. The new bridge will be substantially wider than the existing structure. The northeast corner of the bridge is within the Fresno city limits but the rest of the structure is outside of the current city limits and is within the County's jurisdiction. The City is requesting that the County quit-claim the existing right-of-way for the entire bridge to the City of Fresno. This action will allow the new bridge to be maintained by the City. It will also allow the City to enter into an Encroachment Covenant with Fresno Irrigation District.

The City agrees that maintenance of the improvements can best be performed by one agency, and the City agrees to perform all maintenance for the improvements installed within the area.
