Director Kim Johnson:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) that Fresno County intends to receive to the Transition Grant (FFTA) funding for 2021 through 2025.

By choosing to participate in the Transition Grant funding Fresno County understands they will receive funding through FFTA federal grant to start or continue performing activities related to FFPSA as outlined in All County Letter 21-47. As a condition of receiving the Transition Grant funding, the county commits to submitting data obtained through related prevention planning activities to the CDSS in order to enhance statewide planning efforts.

Fresno County intends to use Transition Grant funding for the following activities (select one or more boxes below and explain the activities per category including intended fund uses in a few sentences):

Prevention Planning Activities:

Identifying and developing a spectrum of services that meet the needs of the community.

Building and Sustaining Local Capacity for Prevention and Early Intervention Services (consistent with Title IV-B allowable activities):

Identifying local providers of EBP services and evaluate opportunities for service expansion.




