

NOTICE is hereby given that at its regularly scheduled meeting on November 5, 2024, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 24-015, an Ordinance of the County of Fresno, State of California.
SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE
The Ordinance to add 10.31, to Title 10 of the County of Fresno Ordinance Code (the "Ordinance Amendment") to declare graffiti to be a public nuisance; to protect public health, safety, and welfare; to demand property owners remove graffiti that is visible from a public location; to authorize abatement of graffiti on private property; to impose administrative fines against property owners who fail to timely remove graffiti; and to discourage the illegal activities attracted by graffiti and blight.
