

PUBLICATION OF SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE BOARD OF  
SUPERVISORS  
COUNTY OF FRESNO

On May 17, 2022, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno adopted the ordinance summarized below.

On March 24, 2022, the Fresno County Planning Commission recommended approval (6 to 0, with two Commissioners absent and one Commission vacancy) to amend the zoning provisions of the Ordinance Code of Fresno County to allow landscaping, limited agriculture, and grazing to be permitted within or adjacent to the Millerton Specific Plan Area when supplied or irrigated with tertiary treated sewage effluent from a municipal sewage system subject to a Classified Conditional Use Permit for specified residential zone districts by amending the text of Sections 823.3, 824.3, 825.3, 826.3, 827.3, and 827.4.c .

In accordance with Government Code Sections 25123, 25131, and 65854-65857, this Ordinance, designated as Ordinance No. R-\_\_\_\_\_-382 shall take effect thirty days after its passage.”
