Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and si	gned into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address
the significant multi-modal transportation funding shor	tfalls statewide; and
WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and	transparency provisions that will ensure the residents
of Fresno County are aware of the projects proposed	for funding in our community and which projects have
been completed each fiscal year; and	
WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolut	ion a list of all projects proposed to receive fiscal year
funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitat	ion Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must
include a description and the location of each prop	osed project, a proposed schedule for the project's
completion, and the estimated useful life of the improv	/ement; and
WHEREAS, the County will receive an estimat	ted \$24,533,062 in RMRA funding in FY 2022-23 from
SB 1; and	
WHEREAS, this is the fifth year in which the C	County is receiving SB 1 funding and such funding will
enable the County to continue essential road maintena	ance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements,
repairing and replacing of aging bridges, and increasi	ng access and mobility options for the traveling public
that would not have otherwise been possible without §	SB 1; and
WHEREAS, the County has undergone a publ	lic process to ensure public input into the community's
transportation priorities and the SB 1 Project List (Exh	ibit A); and
WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement M	Management System to develop the attached SB 1

Project List to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also
 meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate streets/roads,
 bridges, and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the County in FY 2022-23, and provide
 financing for many similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in at-risk condition, and this revenue will help the County increase the overall quality of the road system and over the next decade will improve the general condition of our streets and roads, by bringing selected roads into good-to-excellent condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 Project List and overall investment in local street and road infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, as well as complete street infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits both locally and from a statewide perspective.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno, State of California, as follows:
