WHEREAS, Philanthropy Inspired by the Needs of our Community (PINC) was founded by Analiese Domingos in 2008 in Fresno, California with the goal of joining together a group of women to positively impact the community. Every year the organization raises funds for a different nonprofit organization that primarily serves women and children in Fresno and Madera counties. To date, PINC has raised \$334,500 for local nonprofits; and

WHEREAS, this year, PINC raised \$80,000 - \$15,000 more than its goal – for Feed Our Future, a local nonprofit that provides food for qualifying Fresno County students at select schools on weekends. Past nonprofit recipients include: Angel Babies of Hinds Hospice, Marjaree Mason Center, Make-A-Wish Foundation of Central California, Break the Barriers, Catholic Charities of Fresno, Transitions Children's Services, and Holy Cross Center for Women; and


WHEREAS, currently, there are 39 active members in PINC. Every year these members collaborate to host the annual PINC Party fundraiser; and

WHEREAS, PINC strives to instill compassionate leadership in its members through year-round volunteer service projects. Members have donated countless hours to several local organizations including; Community Food Bank, Poverello House, Nazareth House, Catholic Charities Food Drive, Eye-Q California Classic, and Children's Hospital Central California.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors does hereby recognizes and expresses appreciation for Philanthropy Inspired by the Needs of our Community (PINC) for its dedication to community stewardship through fundraising and volunteerism to benefit local organizations that help those in need in our community.
