8 9	WHEREAS, Carolyn Montez Jorgensen brought the Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure® to Fresno in 1999, which led to the official formation of the Central Valley Affiliate of Susan G. Komen®. In August 2007, Carolyn Montez Jorgensen passed away after a reoccurrence of cancer. She will forever be remembered for her tremendous impact of Fresno County residents by increasing breast cancer awareness and raising funds for education, screening, treatment and saving lives; and
10 11 12	WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1982, Komen has funded more than \$889 million in research and provided \$1.95 billion in funding to screening, education, treatment and psychosocial support programs serving millions of people in more than 30 countries worldwide. \$3.5 million has been invested in the local community for education, screening and treatment programs; thereby assisting 22,000 local residents per year; and
13 14	WHEREAS, The Fresno Affiliate will sponsor the 18 th Annual Susan G. Komen Central Valley Race for the Cure® on September 17, 2016 at the Chukchansi Park, where thousands of residents will come out to support this worthy cause.
15 16	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims September 2016 as "Breast Cancer Awareness Month" in Fresno County and recognizes the Susan G. Komen® Central Valley for their hard work and dedication, and calls upon all Fresno County residents to support and encourage all women to empower themselves with the Four Steps to Breast Self-Awareness.
