1 BEFORE 2 THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 3 OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO STATE OF CALIFORNIA 4 5 6 In the matter of the Resolution No. 16-EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE 7 (EMS) PROGRAM **DESIGNATION OF AN EXCLUSIVE** 8 9 OPERATING AREA FOR THE PROVISION OF **EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICES** 10 11 WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 1797.200, this Board authorized 12 13 the development of an Emergency Medical Services (EMS) program for Fresno County which includes the provision of emergency ambulance services to the residents and visitors of Fresno 14 County; and 15 WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 1797.200, on March 24, 1981, 16 the County of Fresno designated the Fresno County Health Department (which is now the Fresno 17 County Department of Public Health) as the local Emergency Medical Services Agency ("EMS 18 Agency") for Fresno County¹; and 19 20 WHEREAS, this Board acknowledges that the EMS Agency has been planning, 21 implementing and evaluating the emergency medical services system within Fresno County, in accordance with and based upon Division 2.5 of the Health and Safety Code, which is known as 22 the Emergency Medical Services System and Prehospital Emergency Medical Care Personnel Act 23 (the "EMS Act"); and 24 WHEREAS, an exclusive operating area ("EOA") is defined by Section 1797.85 of the 25 26 Health and Safety Code as "an EMS area or subarea defined by the emergency medical services plan for which a local EMS agency, upon the recommendation of a county, restricts operations to 27

one or more emergency ambulance services or providers of limited advanced life support [(EMT-II)] or advanced life support [(paramedic)]"; and

WHEREAS, an "Emergency Medical Services Area" or "EMS Area" is defined by Section 1797.74 of the Health and Safety Code as "the geographical area within the jurisdiction of the designated local EMS agency"; and

WHEREAS, Section 1797.224 of the Health and Safety Code permits a local EMS agency to create one or more EOA's in the development of a local EMS plan; and

WHEREAS, Section 1797.224 of the Health and Safety Code states that "A local EMS agency may create one or more exclusive operating areas in the development of a local plan, if a competitive process is utilized to select the provider or providers of the services pursuant to the plan"; and

WHEREAS, the local EMS agency designated the existing exclusive operating area on December 12, 2006, after a recommendation by the Board; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that the EMS Agency continue the EOA for the Fresno County Emergency Medical Services Exclusive Operating Area, and conduct a competitive selection process for such services, and that such services be provided to the satisfaction of the County of Fresno and the EMS Agency through a written service provider agreement that is acceptable to the County of Fresno and the EMS Agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. This Board finds that the EMS Agency's continuation of an EOA that restricts emergency ambulance services in the Fresno County Emergency Medical Services Exclusive Operating Area would provide for stable and reliable emergency ambulance services with exclusive rights to all emergency ambulance services, which includes 9-1-1 emergency responses, 7-digit emergency responses advanced life support (ALS) ambulance, all critical care transport (CCT) services, ALS interfacility transports, and stand-by services with transport authorization (hereinafter referred to as "Emergency Ambulance Services") in such area, and, as a result, such services to the satisfaction of the County of Fresno and the EMS Agency therefore would be in the best interest of the health and safety of Fresno County residents and visitors. The EMS Agency will designate the

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Fresno County Emergency Medical Services Exclusive Operating Area, defined below, and the terms and conditions of the selected provider's provision of emergency ambulance services shall be governed by a service provider agreement.

- 2. This Board hereby recommends to the EMS Agency that the EMS Agency, by undertaking a competitive selection process for providers of emergency ambulance services designate an EOA that restricts emergency ambulance services in Fresno County in the area designated as the Fresno County Emergency Medical Services Exclusive Operating Area," as shown on Attachment "A1" and "A2."
- 3. This Board acknowledges that the EMS Agency's designation of the Fresno County Emergency Medical Services Exclusive Operating Area for provision of emergency ambulance is conditioned upon and subject to the State EMS Authority's approval of an amendment to the EMS Plan, and any other related approval of such Plan by the State EMS Authority which is submitted thereto by the EMS Agency.
- 4. This Board finds and determines that it took all of the foregoing actions in this resolution in compliance with the EMS Act, and in particular Sections 1797.85 and 1797.224 of the Health and Safety Code. It is the intent of this Board that the County of Fresno, by taking all of the foregoing actions in this resolution and making all such findings, is lawfully carrying out the provisions of the EMS Act as it applies to the subject matter hereof. Therefore, the provisions of this resolution, including any and all actions taken by the County of Fresno hereunder, shall not be intended to act as a substitution for any action that must be taken by, or as a limitation on an authority that must be exercised by, the EMS Agency with regard to the subject matter hereof. To the extent that such action, if any, of this Board is deemed, by a court of competent jurisdiction, to be a substitution for any action that must be taken by, or a limitation on an authority that must be exercised by, the EMS Agency, then this Board acknowledges and resolves that it would have taken such action, or refrained from taking such action referred to herein, which would allow the County of Fresno to lawfully conform its actions herein to the requirements of the EMS Act.
