2	RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 16-467
3	WHEREAS, on November 8, 2016, the voters of the State of California were presented
4	with Proposition 64, titled the "Adult Use of Marijuana Act" (AUMA); and
5	WHEREAS, the purpose of AUMA is to establish a comprehensive system to legalize,
6	control and regulate the cultivation, processing, manufacture, distribution, testing, and sale of
7	nonmedical marijuana, including marijuana products; and
8	WHEREAS, the AUMA would permit cities and counties to completely prohibit the
9	possession, planting, cultivation, harvesting, drying, or processing of nonmedical marijuana
10	outdoors upon the grounds of a private residence; and
11	WHEREAS, the AUMA would also permit cities and counties to completely prohibit the
12	establishment or operation of businesses engaged in commercial nonmedical marijuana
13	activity; and
14	WHEREAS, in light of the AUMA, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors has
15	determined that it is prudent to clarify the County's position relative to the possession,
16	planting, cultivation, harvesting, drying, or processing of nonmedical marijuana outdoors on
17	the grounds of a private residence and the establishment or operation of businesses engaged
18	in commercial marijuana activity in all Zoning Districts of Fresno County; and
19	WHEREAS, a Resolution of Intent is required to initiate the necessary studies and
20	draft proposed amendments to the Ordinance Code of Fresno County for Planning
21	Commission and/or Board consideration; and
22	WHEREAS, after due consideration and deliberation of the information provided in the
23	presentation and the Agenda Item, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors did, on December
24	6, 2016, direct staff to initiate amendments to the Ordinance Code of Fresno County.
