Figure 1: Primary & Secondary Syphilis by Month, Fresno County, 2015.

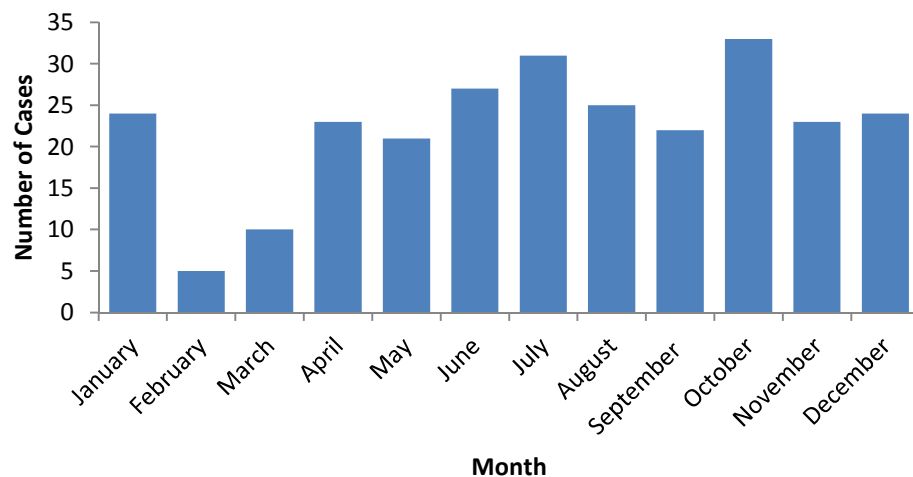


Figure 2: Primary and Secondary Syphilis: Annual Trends 2007 - 2015*.

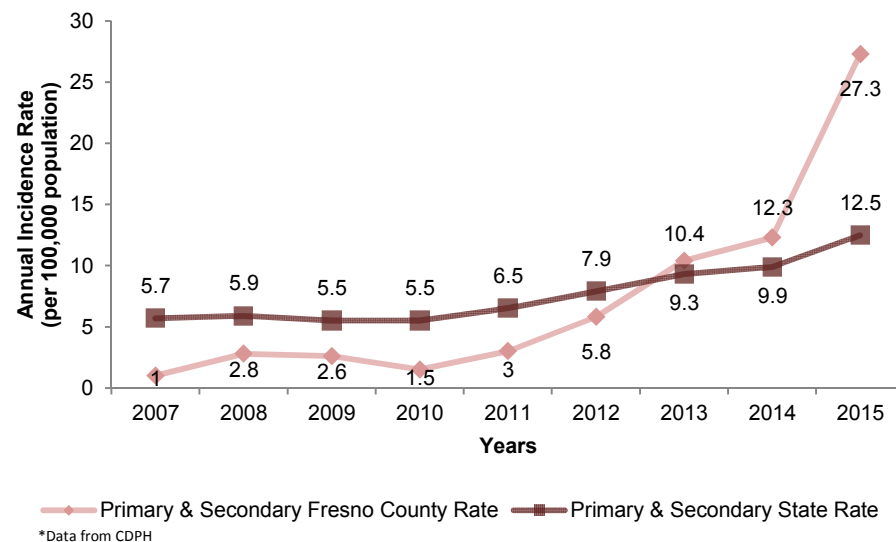

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Figure 3: Congenital Syphilis by Month, Fresno County, 2015.

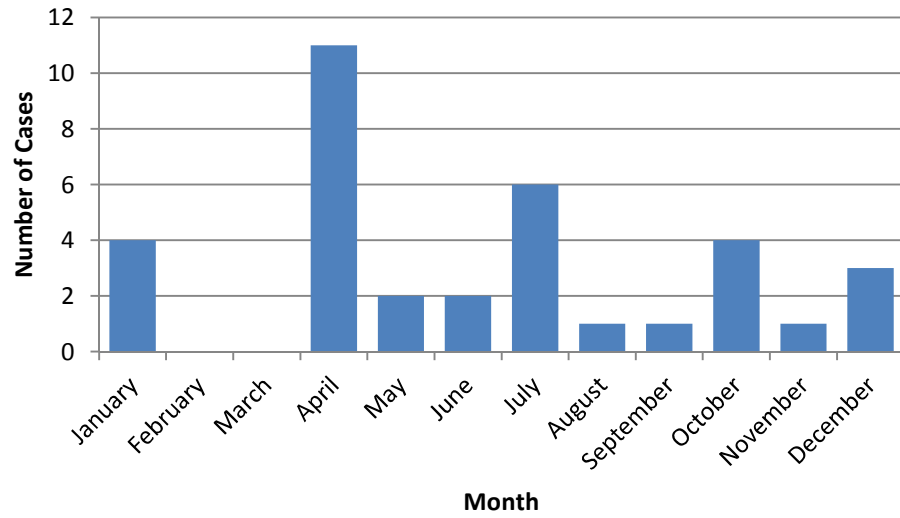


Figure 4: Congenital Syphilis: Annual Trends 2007-2015*.
