WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Governmental Code provides for the appropriations of these funds by a 4/5ths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer –Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2016-17 Budget for County Service Area 33 Organization 9173 as follows:


