IN THE MATTER OF AGRICULTURAL LAND CONSERVATION CONTRACT NOS. 2912 AND 8147 RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING RESCISSION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND CONSERVATION CONTRACT (ALCC) NOS. 2912 & 8147 AND ENTRY INTO AGRICULTURAL LAND CONSERVATION CONTRACT NOS. 8319 & 8320

WHEREAS, Agricultural Land Conservation Contract (ALCC) No. 2912 was entered into between the County of Fresno and Harry Mihara and Dorothy Mihara, and succeeded to by Walter M. Lehrman and Holly E. Lehrman as trustees of the Walter and Holly Lehrman Family Trust dated October 4, 2004, hereafter referred to as "Owners", and recorded February 17, 1971, as Instrument No. 11847, Book 5863, Pages 124 and 124, of the Official Records of Fresno County, California; and

WHEREAS, Agricultural Land Conservation Contract (ALCC) No. 8147 was entered into between the County of Fresno and Walter M. and Holly E. Lehrman and Gustafson Family Living Trust dated December 7, 1994, and succeeded to by TJ Farms, a California general partnership, hereafter referred to as "Owners", and recorded September 24, 2003, as Instrument No. 2003-0231610, of the Official Records of Fresno County, California; and

WHEREAS, Owners wish to adjust boundaries between two contiguous parcels resulting in an approximately 30-acre adjusted Parcel "A" and an approximately 24-acre adjusted Parcel "B". The legal descriptions of the adjusted parcels are attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

WHEREAS, Section 51257 of the California Government Code provides a process where parties may upon their mutual agreement rescind a contract in order to simultaneously enter into a new contract which would enforceably restrict the same property for an initial term at least as long as the unexpired term of the contract being so rescinded but no less than 10 years; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors considered the petition at a public hearing held on February 28, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors approved the RLCC No. 971 based on its ability to make the seven findings listed under Section 51257 of the Government Code as follows:

- 1. That the new contract would enforceably restrict the property for an initial term of no less than 10 years; and
 - 2. That there is no net decrease in the amount of the acreage restricted; and
- 3. That at least 90 percent of the land under the former contract remains under the new contract; and
- 4. That after the Property Line Adjustment, the parcels of land subject to contract will be large enough to sustain their agricultural use; and
- 5. That the Property Line Adjustment would not compromise the long-term agricultural productivity of the parcel or of other contracted lands; and
- 6. The Property Line Adjustment is not likely to result in the removal of adjacent land from agricultural use; and
- 7. That the property line adjustment does not result in a greater number of developable parcels than existed prior to the adjustment, or an adjusted parcel that is inconsistent with the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County and the owners mutually agree to rescind existing Agricultural Land Conservation Contract Nos. 2912 and 8147 and simultaneous entry into new Agricultural Land Conservation Contract Nos. 8319 and 8320.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno approves rescission of Agricultural Land Conservation Contract Nos. 2912 and 8147 and the simultaneous entry into Agricultural Land Conservation Contract Nos. 8319 and 8320 and authorizes the Chairman to execute said contracts. The Clerk to the Board of Supervisors shall cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded together with the executed Contracts in the Office of the County Recorder for the County of Fresno.
