RESOLUTION NO. 17-213

WHEREAS, between October 2015 and September 2016, 495,049 children in California were reported as alleged victims of abuse or neglect, and 21,367 of these alleged victims were children in Fresno County. All adults and caregivers have a responsibility, as neighbors, community members and citizens of Fresno County to help create a healthy, safe and nurturing environment for children and youth. Safe and healthy childhoods help produce confident, successful and independent adults; and

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect often occurs when families or caregivers find themselves in isolated or stressful situations, without community resources, and not knowing how to cope. The majority of child abuse cases stem from situations and conditions that are preventable when our communities are supportive, active and engaged; and

WHEREAS, child abuse and neglect can be reduced by making sure every family has the support it needs to raise their children in a healthy environment and with protective factors or conditions that reduce or eliminate risk and promote the social, emotional, and developmental well-being of children. Effective prevention programs succeed because of meaningful connections and partnerships created between agencies, schools, faith-based organizations, law enforcement agencies, and the business community; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Department of Social Services works diligently to ensure that children remain safe from abuse and neglect and are currently expanding child abuse prevention efforts to reduce the number of children from ever entering the child welfare system; and

WHEREAS, since 1981, the Fresno Council on Child Abuse Prevention (FCCAP), the only primary child abuse prevention agency, has served Fresno County as a Child Abuse Prevention Council. Wearing the color blue or wearing a blue ribbon or displaying a pinwheel in April will serve as a positive reminder that together, we can prevent child abuse and keep children safe.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaim April 2017 as Child Abuse Prevention Awareness Month and urges all citizens to join FCCAP, the Department of Social Services, and their engaged partners, as they support each family's efforts to keep themselves and their children safe, healthy and in a nurturing environment.
