WHEREAS, Communications Dispatcher, Tina Ortiz, retired on March 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff-Coroner has vacant Communications Dispatcher positions;
and


WHEREAS, Communications Dispatchers are critical to the 7x24x365 deployment
of the Sheriff-Coroner's Deputies; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty
(180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees'
Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body finds and certifies the
nature of employment and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed
position before the one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period has passed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of
Supervisors hereby adopts Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Tina Ortiz on an as-
needed basis effective March 28, 2017, finding and certifying that the provisions of
Government Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) separation
period for retired employees returning to employment as extra-Help are not applicable to
Ms. Ortiz, because the nature of Ms. Ortiz's employment and her appointment is
necessary to fill a critically-needed position before 180 days has passed following the
date of Ms. Ortiz's retirement.
