RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FRESNO COUNTY CLERK REGISTRAR OF VOTERS TO PERFORM THE ELECTION AND BILL FOR REIMBURSMENT OF COSTS

WHEREAS, California Election Code section 10002 permits the governing body of a city or district to approve and execute a resolution requesting a county's board of supervisors to permit the county elections official to render services relating to the conduct of an election; and

WHEREAS, California Elections code section 4000 permits a local, special, or consolidated election may be conducted wholly by mail provided that the governing body of the local agency authorizes the use of mailed ballots for the election; the election is held on an established mailed ballot election dated pursuant to Section 1500; and an election on a measure or measures restricted to (A) the imposition of special taxes, or (B) expenditure limitations overrides, or (C) both (A) and (B), in a city, county, or special district with 5,000 or less registered voters calculated as of the time of the last report of registration by the county elections official to the Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, The Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters is the county elections official in Fresno County; and

WHEREAS, The City of Mendota adopted Resolutions Nos. 17-31, 17-32, 17-34 and 17-35 calling for an All-Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election for August 29, 2017. This election will consist of two measures increasing the city's revenue to fund public safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters to conduct the August 29, 2017 All-Mail Ballot Special Municipal Election.
- 2. The Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Clerk/Registrar of Voters to bill the City of Mendota for all costs related to the conduct of the August 29, 2017 All-Mail Ballot Special Election.
