13	that caused water damage on multiple floors; and
14	WHEREAS, on June 19, 2017, the Plaza also sustained a flooding incident, albeit a minor
15	one, that also caused water damage on multiple floors; and
16	WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for preservation of public health, welfare,
17	and safety; and
18	WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for protecting County property; and
19	WHEREAS, the Director of Internal Services/Chief Information Officer, in conjunction with
20	the County Administrative Officer, declared the situation to be an emergency; and
21	WHEREAS, contractors were engaged to perform work necessary for taking the necessary
22	steps to protect County property; and
23	WHEREAS, the nature of the emergencies are such that immediate remediation and
24	restoration was necessary; and
25	WHEREAS, the cost of remediation and restoration will exceed the deductibles on the
26	County's insurance policies and will be paid for by insurance proceeds;
27	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all of the foregoing recitals are true and
28	correct.

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the procurement of services to provide for the
2	remediation and protection of County property without competitive bidding was in the best interest of
3	the County due to the immediate need to obtain services for the protection of County Property.
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interests of the County in restoring County property
5	will be best served through a negotiated contract without competitive bidding by working with and
6	through the County's property insurance carrier.
