WHEREAS, the County owns certain real property known as the Fresno County University Medical Center located at 455 S. Cedar, and the Fresno County Plaza located at 2220 Tulare Street in the City of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2017, the University Medical Center suffered a flooding incident that caused water damage on multiple floors; and

WHEREAS, on June 19, 2017, the Plaza also sustained a flooding incident, albeit a minor one, that also caused water damage on multiple floors; and

WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for preservation of public health, welfare, and safety; and

WHEREAS, there were present an immediate need for protecting County property; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Internal Services/Chief Information Officer, in conjunction with the County Administrative Officer, declared the situation to be an emergency; and

WHEREAS, contractors were engaged to perform work necessary for taking the necessary steps to protect County property; and

WHEREAS, the nature of the emergencies are such that immediate remediation and restoration was necessary; and

WHEREAS, the cost of remediation and restoration will exceed the deductibles on the County's insurance policies and will be paid for by insurance proceeds;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all of the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the procurement of services to provide for the  
2 remediation and protection of County property without competitive bidding was in the best interest of  
3 the County due to the immediate need to obtain services for the protection of County Property.


4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the interests of the County in restoring County property  
5 will be best served through a negotiated contract without competitive bidding by working with and  
6 through the County's property insurance carrier.


