

**NOTICE TO BIDDERS/SUMMARY PROJECT DESCRIPTION** (Public Contract Code § 22037): **CONTRACT NUMBER: 16-12-C, BETHEL AVENUE/MANNING AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL INSTALLATION, FEDERAL PROJECT NUMBER: HSIPL-5942(230)** Sealed proposals will be received at the Fresno County Department of Public Works and Planning (Department), Office of the Design Engineer, Seventh Floor, Fresno County Plaza Building, 2220 Tulare Street, Fresno, CA 93721 until 2:00 P.M., (1400 hours and 00 seconds) Thursday, May 11, 2017 at which time the bidding will be closed. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. Pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.1, any Contractor bidding, or subcontractor to be listed on a bid proposal subject to Public Contract Code Section 4104, shall not be qualified to bid unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. No Contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract or perform work on any contract for public work without proof of current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 to perform public works. The work to be done consists, in general, of installing traffic signal facilities, including, but not limited to, standards, signal heads, controller, electrical service equipment, conduits, loop detectors, and wiring at the intersection of Bethel Avenue and Manning Avenue. The work also includes pavement widening and reconstruction. Signing, striping and pavement markings will also be done. The Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Contract Goal is 10 percent.
