12	(1) That the Board of Supervisors declares its intent to hold a hearing for the vacation of
13	the right-of way more particularly described in Exhibit "A". A map showing the proposed
14	vacation is on file with the Clerk of the Board.
15	(2) That the vacation procedure be conducted under Chapter 3 of Part 3 of Division 9 of
16	the Streets and Highways Code.
17	(3) That a public hearing be set to consider vacation of said right-of-way.
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors to:
19	(1) Adopt the foregoing recitals as true and correct.
20	(2) Direct the Clerk of the Board to publish for at least two successive weeks prior to the
21	hearing, a notice of intent to vacate, and direct the Department of Public Works and Planning to
22	post notice of the same.
23	(3) Set the public hearing to consider vacation of said right-of-way for the hour of 9:00 a.m.
24	on , October 17, 2017 in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, Room 301, Hall of Records,
25	Tulare and "M" Streets, Fresno, California.
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


Exhibit "A"

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

All of that public road right-of-way of 'H' Street, from the east right-of-way line of Howard Avenue, continue easterly approximately 525-feet to the west right-of-way line of 2nd Street, in the Community of Biola. Located in Section 16, Township 13 South, Range 18 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Containing 0.72 acres, more or less.

RESERVING THEREFROM:

For the benefit of **Biola Community Service District** a 20-feet wide easement, centered on the waterline along the south side of the vacated right-of-way, and the right at any time or from time to time, as necessary, pursuant to the provisions of California Streets and Highways Code Section 8340, to construct, maintain, operate, replace, and remove pipelines, transmission lines, valves, manholes, cables, wires, conductors, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the transportation or distribution of electric energy, gas, natural gas, and communications facilities, including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth, and to prevent any building or structure near the facilities and otherwise to protect the same from all hazards in, upon, over and across above described parcel.
