1	AGREEMENT FOR VETERANS MEMORIAL MUSEUM		
2	THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this <u>12th</u> day of <u>September</u> , 2017, between		
3	the COUNTY OF FRESNO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to		
4	as the "COUNTY," and the Veterans Memorial Museum, a non-profit public benefit corporation,		
5	hereinafter referred to as "VETERANS MUSEUM."		
6	WITNESSETH:		
7	WHEREAS, the VETERANS MUSEUM is an association of those whose valor has been		
8	recognized by award of our nation's two highest decorations: The Medal of Honor of the Navy,		
9	Army or Air Force; or the Army Distinguished Service Cross, Navy Cross or Air Force Cross; and		
10	WHEREAS, organized on April 23, 1890, the VETERANS MUSEUM is the nation's senior		
11	organization of veterans chartered by public law 224, an act of Congress, and approved by the		
12	President on August 4, 1955; and		
13	WHEREAS, the VETERANS MUSEUM operates the Fresno Veteran's Memorial Building,		
14	which is physically located at 2425 Fresno Street, Fresno, California, and is dedicated to displaying		
15	objects associated with our country's wars of the past; and		
16	WHEREAS, since its beginning, the VETERANS MUSEUM has concentrated on		
17	recognizing all military veterans of all wars, with emphasis on those that have either joined the		
18	service from Fresno County, or presently reside here; and		
19	WHEREAS, a corridor of flags recognizing each of the U.S. Military Services and Fresno		
20	County veterans groups has been put on display along the entry to the Fresno Veteran's Memorial		
21	Building and a "Lobby of Honor" displays medals with a listing of the Fresno County recipients; and		
22	WHEREAS, the COUNTY is desirous of honoring Fresno County's veterans and preserving		
23	its military history through partially funding the VETERANS MUSEUM herein.		
24	NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:		
25	I. VETERANS MUSEUM'S DUTIES		
26	A. The VETERANS MUSEUM will devote and expend the COUNTY's funds		
27	herein for the promotion, improvement, operation or maintenance of the Veteran's Memorial		
28	Building located in Fresno, California, with the continued recognition of all veterans of all wars with		
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special emphasis for those that have either joined the service from Fresno County or presently
 reside here. VETERANS MUSEUM shall keep records of expenditures related to the
 aforementioned activities.

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COUNTY'S DUTIES

A. COUNTY shall provide funding to the VETERANS MUSEUM in the amount of \$20,000. Said amount shall be paid upon execution of this Agreement and receipt of a valid and proper invoice sent to: The Fresno County Administrative Office, 2281 Tulare Street, Room 304, Fresno, CA 93721.

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III. AUDITS AND INSPECTIONS

10 The VETERANS MUSEUM shall at any time during business hours, and as often as 11 the COUNTY may deem necessary, make available to the COUNTY for examination all of its 12 records and data with respect to the matters covered by this Agreement. The VETERANS 13 MUSEUM shall, upon request by the COUNTY, permit the COUNTY to audit and inspect all of 14 such records and data necessary to ensure that the VETERANS MUSEUM is in compliance with 15 the terms of this Agreement.

16 If this Agreement exceeds Ten Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00), VETERANS
17 MUSEUM shall be subject to the examination and audit of the Auditor General for a period of three
18 (3) years after final payment under contract (Government Code Section 8546.7).

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IV. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

20 In performance of the work, duties and obligations assumed by VETERANS 21 MUSEUM under this Agreement, it is mutually understood and agreed that VETERANS MUSEUM. including any and all of the VETERANS MUSEUM'S officers, agents, employees, and volunteers 22 23 will at all times be acting and performing as an independent contractor, and shall act in an 24 independent capacity and not as an officer, agent, servant, employee, joint venturer, partner, or 25 associate of the COUNTY. Furthermore, COUNTY shall have no right to control or supervise or direct the manner or method by which the VETERANS MUSEUM shall perform its work and 26 27 function. However, COUNTY shall retain the right to administer this Agreement so as to verify that the VETERANS MUSEUM is performing its obligations in accordance with the terms and 28

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conditions thereof. VETERANS MUSEUM and COUNTY shall comply with all applicable
 provisions of law and the rules and regulations, if any, of governmental authorities having
 jurisdiction over matters the subject thereof.

4 Because of its status as an independent contractor, VETERANS MUSEUM waives 5 any and all employment rights and benefits available to County employees. VETERANS MUSEUM 6 shall be solely liable and responsible for providing to, or on behalf of, its employees all legally-7 required employee benefits. In addition, VETERANS MUSEUM shall be solely responsible and 8 save COUNTY harmless from all matters relating to payment of VETERANS MUSEUM'S 9 employees, including compliance with Social Security, withholding, and all other regulations 10 governing such matters. It is acknowledged that during the term of this Agreement, VETERANS 11 MUSEUM may be providing services to others unrelated to the COUNTY or to this Agreement. 12 VETERANS MUSEUM hereby represents and warrants to COUNTY that all personnel staff presently, and for the foreseeable future, performing duties at the VETERANS MUSEUM are 13 volunteers and as such, neither receive nor have any reasonable expectation of receiving any 14 15 benefits that are made available to COUNTY employees.

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V. INSURANCE PROVIDED BY CONTRACTOR

Without limiting the COUNTY's right to obtain indemnification from VETERANS
MUSEUM or any third parties, VETERANS MUSEM, at its sole expense, shall carry such policies
of insurance in sufficient amounts to cover VETERANS MUSEUM's liabilities relating to General
Liability and Worker's Compensation.

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VI. INDEMNIFICATION

The VETERANS MUSEUM shall hold the COUNTY, its officers and employees, harmless, and indemnify and defend the COUNTY, its officers and employees, from any and all costs and expenses (including attorneys fees and costs) claims, suits, damages, and losses occurring or resulting to any person, firm, or corporation who may be injured or damaged by the VETERANS MUSEUM, its officers, employees, volunteers or subcontractors, in connection with the VETERANS MUSEUM's performance of or failure to perform this Agreement. The provisions of this Section VI shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

2		This Agreement may be amended with the mutual written consent of the parties

4	VIII.	TERM AND TERMINATION	
5		A. <u>Term</u> - The term of this Agreement shall be from October 1, 2017, to and	
6	including June	e 30, 2018, unless it is earlier terminated as provided herein.	
7	n 25.	B. <u>Termination - Non-Allocation of Funds</u> - The terms of this Agreement, and	
8	the services to	o be provided hereunder, are contingent on the approval of funds by the appropriating	
9	government a	agency. Should sufficient funds not be allocated, the services provided may be	
10	modified, or th	nis Agreement terminated at any time by giving the VETERANS MUSEUM thirty (30)	
11	days advance written notice.		
12		C. <u>Termination – Without Cause</u> - This Agreement may be terminated by either	
13	of the parties	upon the giving of thirty (30) days written notice to the other party prior to the date of	
14	termination.		
15		D. <u>Breach</u> - COUNTY, upon giving written notice to VETERANS MUSEUM, may	
16	immediately s	uspend or terminate this Agreement in whole or in part, where in the determination of	
17	COUNTY there	e is on the part of VETERANS MUSEUM any of the following:	
18		1. An illegal or improper use of funds;	
19		2. A failure to comply with any term of this Agreement;	
20		3. A substantially incorrect or incomplete report submitted to COUNTY; or	
21		4. Improperly performed service.	
22	Agreement	In no event shall any payment by COUNTY to VETERANS MUSEUM under this	
23		onstitute a waiver by COUNTY of any breach of this Agreement by VETERANS	
24		any default which may then exist on the part of VETERANS MUSEUM. Neither shall	
25		impair or prejudice any remedy available to COUNTY with respect to the breach or	
26		NTY shall have the right to demand of VETERANS MUSEUM the repayment to	
27		any funds disbursed to VETERANS MUSEUM under this Agreement, which in the	
28	juagment of (COUNTY were not expended in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.	

1 VETERANS MUSEUM shall promptly refund any such funds upon demand.

E. <u>Return of COUNTY funds</u>. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Agreement, in the event of any early termination of this Agreement, VETERANS MUSEUM shall, within thirty (30) days thereof, return to COUNTY the prorated portion of COUNTY funds that COUNTY has provided herein to VETERANS MUSEUM, based on the remaining number of full months that otherwise would have accrued during the term of this Agreement.

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IX. ASSIGNMENT

8 The VETERANS MUSEUM may not assign or transfer its rights, or delegate, 9 transfer, or sub-contract its obligations, under this Agreement, unless authorized in writing by 10 COUNTY.

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X. DISCLOSURE OF SELF-DEALING TRANSACTIONS

12 Members of the VETERANS MUSEUM's board of directors shall disclose any self-13 dealing transactions that they are a party to while VETERANS MUSEUM is providing goods or 14 performing services under this Agreement. A self-dealing transaction shall mean a transaction to 15 which the VETERANS MUSEUM is a party and in which one or more of its directors has a material financial interest. Members of the VETERANS MUSEUM board of directors shall disclose any self-16 17 dealing transactions that they are a party to by completing and signing a Self-Dealing Transaction Disclosure Form (Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference) 18 19 and submitting it to the COUNTY prior to commencing with the self-dealing transaction or immediately thereafter. 20

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XI. <u>GOVERNING LAW</u>

Venue for any action arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall only be in
 Fresno County, California.

The rights and obligations of the parties and all interpretation and performance of this Agreement shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the State of California.

26 XII. <u>ENTIRE AGREEMENT</u>

This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the VETERANS MUSEUM and COUNTY with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all previous

1	negotiations, proposals, commitments, writings, advertisements, publications, and understandings
2	of any nature whatsoever unless expressly included in this Agreement.
