Total cost of the acquisition is not to exceed \$977,658.00 for five years. Years 1-3 are not to exceed \$561,801.00. Potential renewal terms for years 4 and 5 are subject to CPI increases. Estimated costs for years four and five are not to exceed \$415,857.00

ITSD staff began researching consulting and exeuctive coaching firms to identify those who offered the most comparable and complete services that meet the department's needs. Through that research, three companies were identified as providing Executive Leadership programs, IT research and consultation services: (1) Gartner, Inc., (2) Forrester Research, Inc., and (3) International Data Corporation (IDC). After having conversations with representatives of each organization, ITSD learned that only Gartner, Inc. has an executive coaching program that fully addresses department goals. The representative from Forrester, Inc. indicated that their company's focus is on service to end-users, and while they had research and resources to assist in infrastructure development, if that was the County's main focus, Gartner's services would be better suited to the County's needs. The department's concern with IDC is that they do not have a presence in California with the public sector.
